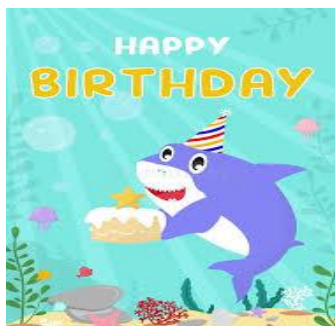


## We need a Secretary!!!


