

CORRECT METHOD TO MEASURE A FISH FOR PHOTO'S:

Fish are to be clear of sand and correctly placed on an official

NSW DPI Catch & Release Mat.

The overall measurement of a fish, whether it is fork-tailed or round tailed, is taken from the snout on the upper jaw to the FORK of the tail.



Mouth Closed (where possible) & tip of upper jaw touches the end, V of tail to be along the midline measure.



DUSKY FLATHEAD: The whole fish is to be in the photo and show the black spot at the caudle end of tail. This may be best seen when laid on it's side.

If the length is longer than the Official Brag Mat allows, a clearly marked tape measure can be used alongside to show actual measurement.
